



2022-23 Quality Dollar Table

To better address funding needs for early childhood providers and Preschool sites, the 2022-23 school year Quality Dollars for private ODJFS-licensed child care sites and private ODE-licensed sites will be based on base funding plus per-child stipends. Quality Dollars for public school Preschool providers and for MVCDC Head Start will be based only on per-child stipends.

This table summarizes the maximum funding available to participating Preschool Promise sites. Funds must be used for approved purposes such as: increasing teacher wages, purchasing curriculum for Preschool classrooms, paying for training for Preschool teachers, purchasing needed equipment for classrooms, offering expanded services to children in the program. Requests must support a program's Continuous Improvement Plan and be submitted to Preschool Promise for approval.
