Make a game of recognizing letters



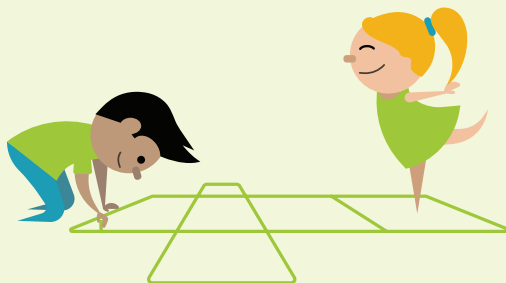
Practice counting to 10
